Upon successful completion of the course assessments you will awarded a: 91235NSW –Diploma of Clinical Hypnotherapy & Neuro-Linguistic Programming

Participants who exit the training program without completing all assessments will be issued with a statement of attainment for those units in which they have demonstrated competency.

The qualification process also recognises your existing skills and knowledge. Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is a process where the participants existing skills and knowledge are matched against the requirements of the qualification. If the participant is assessed as already having achieved competency the course is reduced in duration. Additional information on our RPL process is available from the Australian College of Hypnotherapy Office.

The format for delivery/assessment will be designed around a twelve to fifteen month delivery program involving a combination of theory/classroom sessions and practical work based sessions to be conducted in a classroom setting and in the participant's workplace.

To be eligible to enrol in our training programs participants must be able to read and write English to a sufficient standard to work with the supplied texts.
